Reading Layer 1: Whole-School Long-Term Plan (Reading Spine for Fiction, Non-fiction and Poetry texts)

Detailed information about our reading curriculum and reading spine can be found in our reading vision document - 'Being a Reader at Millbrook'.

This document summarises the texts we are using in each year group to teach **reading skills** (core texts) and to develop **reading for pleasure** (class readers).

Texts for teaching reading skills - Core texts

In Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, decoding and fluency skills are taught daily using the Read Write Inc (RWI) scheme.

Other reading skills (taught using the VAT framework) are covered partially through the RWI scheme and partially through our high-quality core reading texts that are introduced throughout the year in the table below.

In Years 3-6, reading skills are taught during daily reading lessons through high-quality texts, using the VAT framework for Reading.

The core texts that we have chosen have been sequenced to ensure progression of skills and knowledge across Reception to Year 6.

Reading for pleasure texts – Class readers

At Millbrook, we believe that small daily acts of reading matter. For this reason, the Millbrook reading spine also includes 'reading for pleasure' books, which are enjoyed during 'class reader' time after lunch each day.

Rationale for our text choices

All of our texts are carefully chosen to introduce and develop new vocabulary. Furthermore, we have a clear rationale for each text; this may be because the book has a moral message or reflects a particular theme such as diversity, refugees, our natural world, friendship, empathy, citizenship, Black heroes, 'Healthy me, Safe me' or to support another area of our curriculum.








